4.4 <u>Acknowledgement and Authorization in Furtherance of the Dissolution of the</u> <u>F.I.T. Student-Faculty Corporation and the Transfer of its Assets and Liabilities to the College</u>

RESOLVED,

1. That (i) no future allocations of Food Services Revenues and Book Store Revenues shall be made to the Corporation, resulting in one hundred percent (100%) of the Food Service Revenues and Book Store Revenues remaining solely with the College from and after the date hereof, (ii) the arrangement by which the Corporation had the right to enter into third-party rental agreements for college space is hereby terminated and all such agreements shall be made and entered into directly between the College and such third parties from and after the date hereof, and (iii) the form of Assignment and Assumption Agreement is hereby authorized and approved.

2. That any and all acts of any member of the Board of Trustees of the College or any officer of the College prior to the date hereof and in connection with the matters referred to in the preceding recitals and these Resolutions, are hereby in each and every respect ratified, confirmed, adopted and approved as acts of the College.

3. That any member of the Board of Trustees of the College or any officer of the College (each an "Authorized Signatory") is hereby directed and authorized to take all steps required by law or that are otherwise necessary and appropriate to carry out the foregoing Resolutions, including the execution, delivery or recording of any and all documents, consents, certificates and/or instruments, including without limitation, the Assignment and Assumption Agreement, required in connection with the matters contemplated herein or relating hereto, with such changes as any Authorized Signatory may deem necessary, proper and advisable to effectuate the purposes of the foregoing Resolutions.

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
